

2010 Senior Lacrosse – Process and Information

To all Graduating Midget players; WELCOME TO SENIOR LACROSSE IN DELTA

There is no general registration at the senior level, and this will outline the process for playing on a team this year.

Delta runs two Intermediate teams: A and B. The A team is the rep team. Some associations don't have an A team, and they release their players to try out with other associations in the hope that they will make an A team elsewhere. Because of this, Delta can sign players from all over BC, and competition can get tough. To begin the process there will be a training camp on March 9th, 2 – 5pm, March 10th, 3 – 5pm and March 11th, 2 – 5pm, 2010. The Intermediate A coaches will be there evaluating players skills, but the camp is open for all intermediate players.

After the conclusion of the training camp, the Intermediate A coaches will probably call a tryout which will be by invitation, to select their team. If you do not make the Intermediate A team here in Delta, you have two choices:

- (a) you can choose to play Intermediate B in South Delta, or
- (b) you can try out with another association that offers an Intermediate A program.

You cannot try out for any other association unless you have been 'cut' from the Delta A team. If you are selected to play for a team other than Delta, that is where you will play for the duration of the season.

If you choose to stay in Delta, then your next move would be to try out for the Intermediate B team here. The Intermediate B team is also a competitive team. Both teams begin play in mid-April and go to provincials the August long weekend (July 30th – August 1st).

If you do not make any other Intermediate A team then you must come back to South Delta to play Intermediate B – there are no releases in senior except what is outlined above.

When you are chosen to play for either the Intermediate A or the Intermediate B team, the coach will ask you and your parents to sign a card. This is sent to the league to register you for the playing season, and will register you to that team for the playing season. You must only sign one card per season.

During the season, you may be called up to play on another Delta team, with the permission of your coach. Intermediate B players may be called up to play Intermediate A or perhaps Junior B, and Intermediate A players may get the chance to play some Junior A or Junior B.
